

 Unsuitable for excessive note taking


Classroom




- · Medium-large groups
- · Space for taking notes and laying out materials



· Requires a large room



Boardroom






- Small groups
- · Can double up for private dining
- · Most venues have facilities for this



 Many boardrooms have 'fixed' nonadaptable furnishings



U-shaped





- Smaller groups
- Maximum interaction with presenter



 Unsuitable for 40+ delegates


Cabaret




- Small groups at each table
- AV at the front



- Requires a large room
- Difficult to ensure everyone can see



Dinner





- Large event but broken into small groups
- Stage and dance floor can be added



- Requires large room
- Adding extras will reduce space for seating
